



Guide to connecting to CTM-Public Network

- On your wireless capable device, click on the wireless network **CTM-Public**
- Once you have connected to the wireless network named **CTM-Public**, you will be presented with the splash page pictured to the right.
- For first time users, you will need to register for an account.
Note: This account will be valid for 6 weeks, and then it will expire. When your account expires, you are welcome to re-register by completing the registration process as below. You may use the same username, email and phone number details.
- Complete the fields under “Registration” and click “Register”:
 - **Username:** this can be any unique name, e.g. John.Smith
 - **Email:** a valid email address.
Note: Your password will be sent via email to this address
 - **Phone:** complete this if you require your password to be sent to you via SMS
Note: Please enter in the following format:
Country code + drop leading zero of mobile number
Eg: 0400 123 123 enter as 61400 123 123.
- Your login and password will be sent to you via email or SMS. You will be redirected to the login page. Enter your username and password, then click “Log in”
- You should now be connected to the **CTM-Public** wireless network
Note: Acceptable Usage Policy can be found by selecting “Use Policy” on the splash page.
